# LITTLE GUY FOOTBALL INFORMATION SHEET

**COST:** \$80.00 per participant; \$140.00 per family for 2 or more children playing. Please make all checks payable to <u>DLGF</u> or <u>Dayton Little Guy Football</u>. Mouthpieces are available for \$1.00. Personalized jerseys are optional, at \$35.00.

**DEPOSIT:** Due to difficulties in getting gear returned to Dayton Little Guy Football, we are forced to require a <u>deposit</u> of \$100.00. Upon all gear being returned, the deposit check will be returned.

### **PRACTICE**

- -- Days and times for practices will be determined by the coaches.
- --Players will need a practice shirt. Dad's old T-shirts work great for this or the scarlet red jerseys from prior years uniforms. **No game jerseys are to be worn to practice**.

### **GEAR**

- **--Equipment hand out dates will be announced soon**. This will include a game jersey, shoulder pads, game pants, and air helmets. For those ordering game jerseys: the order will be turned in by Friday, September 11th, and will need to be paid for by that date. The cost this year is \$35.00. Also, because of past problems, the \$80.00 sign-up fee will need to be paid before a jersey order is accepted.
- --Players are expected to have clean pants, jerseys, and helmets on game days. (Let's look good)
- --Shoes will need to be supplied by player/parents. These can be tennis shoes or non-metal spike football shoes.
- --Each player will need to have a mouthguard, with a helmet strap. You can purchase your own or buy one from Dayton Little Guy Football for \$1.00.

## **EXPECTATIONS**

- --It is more important that young people get an education than it is that they play football. The players grades will be reviewed to see how each player is doing. Players not putting forth good effort in the classroom, according to teachers or parents, will not play.
- --Players are to be at practice. Those that are not, should not expect to play in the games.
- --Players that do not put forth good effort or are not cooperative in practice should not expect to play in the games.
- --Foul language will not be tolerated from players, parents or coaches.
- --We will be doing our community clean-up project and pizza party toward the end of the season as a way to say thank you to the School District for letting us use their facilities. <u>All players</u> need to plan to attend.
